HSSOA Season Overview

- On the field, HSSOA provided 19,799 officiating positions for 7,804 games. This is believed to be the largest number of games in Chapter history. Middle School games saw notable growth.
- HSSOA had 293 members who were active officials. 63 members officiated in more than one hundred games, providing 43% of the total officiating positions. Arturo Gomez officiated in an astounding 223 games.
- Total gross earnings for members is estimated at \$1.1 million, an average of \$55.56 per game. Members averaged 68 officiating positions for the season, earning \$3,778.
- For High School District games there were an average of 2.7 officials per game, meaning most matches were undertaken by three official crews.
- Finances significantly improved as income grew, expenses were below target and considerable effort was made to significantly reduce payables and receivables.

- June 2022, the first month of the season's accounts, saw material income from Houston ISD to pay officials for the previous season. This method of paying members have been discontinued and they are now paid directly from the Houston ISD.
- Several thousand dollars of aged ISD debts were recouped over the summer.
- Annual Chapter costs were below plan for the season.
- Non-Operating expenses are mainly refunds of money held for active and past referees.



- From Palacios to Baytown and Hempstead to Galveston the Chapter covers a large geography and hugely diverse population. Houston is proudly a 2026 World Cup host city.
